

### INDEPENDENT ASSURANCE REPORT

To the management of Comsign Ltd. ("Comsign"):

### Scope

We have been engaged, in a reasonable assurance engagement, to report on Comsign management's assertion that for its Certification Authority (CA) operations at Atidim Teach Park, building #4 Tel-Aviv, Israel, throughout the period from April 27, 2022 to April 26, 2023 for its CAs as enumerated in Attachment A self-signed Root Keys CAs and Subordinate CAs in scope, Comsign's has:

- disclosed of its business, key lifecycle management, certificate lifecycle management, and CA environmental control practices in its:
  - o Comsign's Certification Practice Statement (CPS) Version 5.1 (English Version).
  - o Comsign's Certification Practice Statement (CPS) Version 5.1 (<u>Hebrew Version</u>).
- maintained effective controls to provide reasonable assurance that:
  - o Comsign's Certification Practice Statements are consistent with its Certificate Policies
  - Comsign provides its services in accordance with its Certificate Policies and Certification
     Practice Statements
- maintained effective controls to provide reasonable assurance that:
  - o the integrity of keys and certificates it manages is established and protected throughout their lifecycles;
  - o the integrity of subscriber keys and certificates it manages is established and protected throughout their lifecycles;
  - o subscriber information is properly authenticated (for the registration activities performed by Comsign); and
  - o subordinate CA certificate requests are accurate, authenticated, and approved
- maintained effective controls to provide reasonable assurance that:
  - o logical and physical access to CA systems and data is restricted to authorised individuals;
  - o the continuity of key and certificate management operations is maintained; and
  - o CA systems development, maintenance, and operations are properly authorised and performed to maintain CA systems integrity

in accordance with the WebTrust Principles Criteria for Certification Authorities v2.2.2.

Comsign does not escrow its CA keys, does not provide certificate rekey services, does not provide subscriber key escrow services, does not provide subscriber key management services, and does not provide subscriber key storage and recovery services. Accordingly, our procedures did not extend to controls that would address those criteria.



### Certification authority's responsibilities

Comsign's management is responsible for its assertion, including the fairness of its presentation, and the provision of its described services in accordance with the <u>WebTrust Principles Criteria for Certification</u> Authorities v2.2.2.

### Our independence and quality control

We have complied with the independence and other ethical requirements of the Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants issued by the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants, which are founded on fundamental principles of integrity, objectivity, professional competence and due care, confidentiality and professional behavior.

The firm applies International Standard on Quality Control 1, Quality Control for Firms that Perform Audits and Reviews of Historical Financial Information, and Other Assurance and Related Services. Engagements and accordingly maintains a comprehensive system of quality control including documented policies and procedures regarding compliance with ethical requirements, professional standards and applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

### Practitioner's responsibilities

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on management's assertion based on our procedures. We conducted our procedures in accordance with International Standard on Assurance Engagements 3000, Assurance Engagements Other than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information, issued by the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board. This standard requires that we plan and perform our procedures to obtain reasonable assurance about whether, in all material respects, management's assertion is fairly stated, and, accordingly, included:

- (1) obtaining an understanding of Comsign's key and certificate lifecycle management business practices and its controls over key and certificate integrity, over the authenticity and confidentiality of subscriber and relying party information, over the continuity of key and certificate lifecycle management operations and over development, maintenance and operation of systems integrity;
- (2) selectively testing transactions executed in accordance with disclosed key and certificate lifecycle management business practices;
- (3) testing and evaluating the operating effectiveness of the controls; and
- (4) performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

We believe that the evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

The relative effectiveness and significance of specific controls at Comsign and their effect on assessments of control risk for subscribers and relying parties are dependent on their interaction with the controls, and other factors present at individual subscriber and relying party locations. We have performed no procedures to evaluate the effectiveness of controls at individual subscriber and relying party locations.



#### Inherent limitations

There are inherent limitations in the effectiveness of any system of internal control, including the possibility of human error and the circumvention of controls. For example, because of their nature, controls may not prevent, or detect unauthorised access to systems and information, or failure to comply with internal and external policies or requirements. Also, the projection to the future of any conclusions based on our findings is subject to the risk that controls may become ineffective.

### Opinion

In our opinion, throughout the period from April 27, 2022 to April 26, 2023 Comsign management's assertion, as referred to above, is fairly stated, in all material respects, in accordance with the the <u>WebTrust Principles and Criteria for Certification Authorities v2.2.2</u>.

This report does not include any representation as to the quality of Comsign's services beyond those covered by the <u>WebTrust Principles and Criteria for Certification Authorities v2.2.2</u>, nor the suitability of any of Comsign's services for any customer's intended purpose.

Comsign Ltd. ("Comsign") operates the Certification Authority (CA) services known as:-Root Keys: "Comsign Global Root CA" and "Comsign International Root CA"; Subordinate CAs: ComSign ISA Global CA, ComSign Corporations CA, ComSign Professionals CA, Comsign IDF CA, Comsign eIDAS CA and ComSign Organizational CA and provide the following CA services:

- Subscriber Registration
- Certificate Renewal
- Certificate Issuance
- Certificate Revocation
- Certificate Suspension
- Certificate Validation and
- Subscriber key generation.

The management of Comsign is responsible for establishing and maintaining effective controls over its CA operations, including its CA business practices disclosure on its website, CA business practice management, CA environmental controls, CA key life cycle management controls, certificate lifecycle management controls, and subordinate CA certificate lifecycle management controls. These controls contain monitoring mechanisms and actions taken to correct deficiencies identified.

There are inherent limitations in any controls, including the possibility of human error, and the circumvention or overriding of controls. Accordingly, even effective controls can only provide reasonable assurance with respect to Comsign's Certification Authority operations. Furthermore, because of changes in conditions, the effectiveness of controls may vary over time.

Comsign management has assessed its disclosure of its certificate practices and controls over its CA services.
